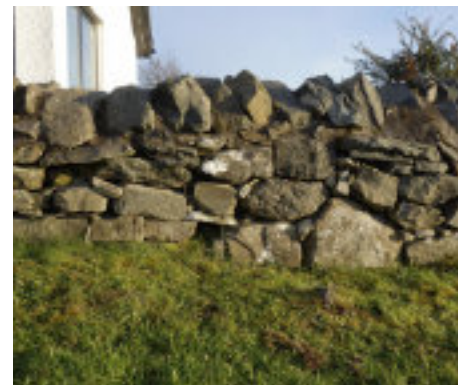


## Picnic seating

Potential to re-use and supplement existing with rectangular style seats. For full accessibility, new recycled plastic tables and benches could be installed, which remove requirement to step into seating, which can be difficult for disabled users.



## Interpretive feature

An attractive and interesting centrepiece to the shorefront. Stone walls and information boards create a place to sit and watch the seashore as well as engaging and informing visitors to the area.

## Surfacing

Resin bound gravel creates a hard wearing, smooth and attractive surface for paths, with a bound stone surface as a more cost effective alternative. Bitmac parking bays can be delineated by granite setts as an alternative to line marking, sensitive to landscape setting.



## Planting

Introducing planting brings colour and life to the area, softening expanded surfaced areas and creating a gentle transition from shore to shop front. A hardy fir can be planted to provide a community tree for Christmas now and into the future.
